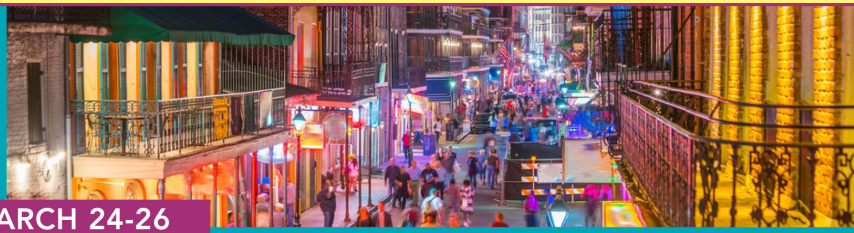

## REMARKABLE CASES SESSION

The Louisiana Chapter, American College of Surgeons invites Residents and Fellows (ACS and Associate Fellows only) to submit case studies to be considered for presentations during an interactive case presentation session at the **2023 LA-ACS Annual Meeting**.

We are looking for cases that place an **emphasis** on the use of **new techniques, new technologies, and new ways of using existing techniques and technologies to improve surgical outcomes**.

### We are looking for surgical cases and experiences that:

- Are **not routinely seen** in practice
- That were treated in a **unique** fashion
- Cases/experiences where the clinical presentation and/or challenge of management produced knowledge and insights that **have educational value**
- welcome cases that place an emphasis on the use of new techniques, new technologies, and new ways of using existing techniques and technologies to **improve surgical outcomes**

The top **5 submissions** will be selected (and required) to share their case live at the 2023 LA-ACS Annual Meeting an interactive and engaging “Remarkable Cases” session in which all attendees of the meeting will be present. This session will encourage interactive discussion between you (the presenter), the moderators, and the audience.

Your case will be judged by a group of experts, and the winner of the competition will have their case submitted to the **ACS Case Reviews in Surgery Competition**, where your case is guaranteed review for the publication *ACS Case Reviews*. Additionally, the winner of the competition will receive a free one-year subscription to this journal (annual subscriptions are \$125 with CME and \$75 without CME).

### ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- This competition is open to Residents and Fellows (ACS Fellows and Associate Fellows only), **please note that Resident submissions must have an ACS Fellow included as an author**. Resident presenters must be a member of the ACS.
- If you are selected to present onsite, more details regarding logistics and presentation requirements will be sent to you individually. Additionally, **you must register for the meeting**.
- If the case study has been published previously or is being considered for publication, it is **not eligible** for submission to this competition.
- Structure: **Background, Summary, Case Description, Discussion, Conclusion, Lessons Learned**.
- Only **two** attachments allowed.
- The submission deadline is **Sunday, November 6th at 11:59pm**.
